## **SIGNIFICANCE:**

Considered by many the most beautiful coin in the world, the 1907 High Relief \$20 is one of the most popular United States coins. President Theodore Roosevelt strongly disliked the design of U.S. coins during that time period and wanted to represent to the world the strength of the United States. As such, he hired one of the most popular sculptors of the time, August St. Gaudens to design U.S. coinage. The 1907 High Relief is an incredible coin because the relief of the coin is so high that the coin is almost 3 dimensional. Banks did not like the high reliefs as the coins were difficult to stack so the following year and through 1932, St. Gaudens were struck with a low relief. The 1907 high relief was only struck for one year. For its beauty and one year design, the High Relief is an extremely popular U.S. rare coin making this piece a fantastic investment opportunity.
